

Glimpse of town's new community centre

This is an artist's aerial impression of what Bungay's new community centre and play park will look like.

As reported in the Beccles and Bungay Journal, the £2m scheme has now been given planning permission by Waveney planners, and the task of funding it will now be redoubled.

The centre, designed by the OWL Partnership, and to be built at the old grammar school field in St John's Road, is capable of seating 150 for a sit down meal, or 200 when

using a canopy extension, and will also have other meeting rooms and starter business facilities, among other assets.

In this impression the play park, which will have play equipment for all ages - that for very small children will be close to the patio where parents can sit and watch them play - is in the bottom left hand corner, adjacent to the existing skate park. St John's Road is at the bottom of this picture, with Old Grammar Lane and the former school, now residential units, to the top.
